CANDIDATES:

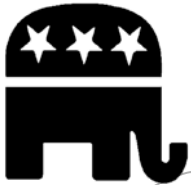
To vote for a person, whose name is printed on the ballot, darken the oval to the left of the name of the person for whom you wish to vote.

PROPOSITION C
Proposed by 95th General Assembly
(Second Regular Session)
SS SCS HCS House Bill 1764

Shall the Missouri Statutes be amended to:
